# Writing or Behind the Scenes

These questions focus on your current work in progress (WIP) and/or general writing topics.

- 1. Talk about your current story (WIP) and how will be new or different from others in your subgenre
- 2. Share your research process
- 3. Share how you organize your writing (e.g. Scrivener? Post-Its? Notecards? The Romance Author Novel Organizer)
- 4. Talk about the people who have helped you with your book (research interviewees, editor, cover designer, etc)
- 5. Talk about the inspiration behind your current book or a post for each of your books.
- 6. Share the darlings you killed (deleted scenes)
- 7. Share a picture of your writing space and talk about how it inspires or motivates you to write
- 8. Introduce your readers locations in your book including pictures and interesting factoids
- 9. Share your writing process
- 10. Create a playlist of the music you like to listen to while you write
- 11. Share how you market your books
- 12. Share a scene or chapter of your current WIP and ask for feedback
- 13. Tell how you celebrate when you write "The End" on a book
- 14. Explain how you write certain elements of a romance, such as the meet cute or the first kiss.
- 15. Create a mood board for your current WIP (you can do this on Pinterest, or create an image in Canva)
- 16. How you world-build your novels
- 17. Your writing routine
- 18. Where or how you get ideas for your book
- 19. Share your morning routine
- 20. Share other places you write (e.g. library or café)
- 21. What is in your writer's toolbox? Computer, software, books, etc
- 22. Write a post about how readers can join your launch team.
- 23. A day in the life of you as an author
- 24. Who would you cast if your book became a movie/tv show?
- 25. Serialize a story
- 26. Bonus content.

# Fan Engagement

These are topics in which reader fans provide the content you blog about.

1. Have fans submit an idea, randomly pick one, and write a short story or scene to post on your blog.

- 2. Feature one of your readers on your blog
- 3. Ask fans on social media what they like in a romance book, and then write a post about how your new book fits into what they like
- 4. If you're in a writers group or network with other authors, feature one of them on your blog
- 5. Have your readers help you create your TBR list
- 6. Have your readers help you create an "If You Like" list that has books similar to yours
- 7. Have your fans submit questions that you answer on your blog
- 8. Ask fans for input or to vote on the names of your upcoming characters
- 9. Have fans vote on your next book cover (on social media) and write a post about the winner
- 10. Create interactive content
- 11. Host a contest
- 12. Ask for input on merch designs.
- 13. Ask fans to share photos with your book, fan art or videos, and share them on your blog.

### **About the Author**

These are general about you as a writer, or writing that isn't your WIP

- 1. Share the first piece you ever wrote and how you've grown or changed as a writer
- 2. Share the story of how you became a writer (who inspired you, first story spark, etc)
- 3. Your writing journey (how you started, where you are now, and where you want to go)
- 4. Write about an author who has influenced your writing
- 5. Share articles or news bits that you find interesting
- 6. Share the hardest thing about being a writer
- 7. Talk about the best thing about being a writer
- 8. Who is your writing hero?
- 9. What was the best review you have received for a book?
- 10. What was your worst review for a book?
- 11. Share "Mean Reviews" similar to "Mean Tweets"
- 12. Highlight authors that you like and what you like about their books and writing
- 13. Share books that made an impression on you and why
- 14. Do you battle writers block? How do you work through that?
- 15. Share struggles you face when writing and how you have work through them
- 16. Share how you published your first book
- 17. Celebrate milestones such as sales, anniversaries, awards, etc
- 18. Events you've attended or plan to attend
- 19. Future story ideas
- 20. Favorite reading resources and apps

### **About Your Books or Characters**

- 1. Profile a person who inspired a character in your book.
- 2. Share your character's backstory
- 3. Share how you create your characters
- 4. Write the blog post as one of the characters in your book (49).
- 5. What struggles do your characters face?
- 6. Create music playlists for your characters or books
- 7. Are your characters based on people you know? Share how they inspired your character.
- 8. If your book is historical fiction, write about what life was like during that time
- 9. Pets and animals in your novels
- 10. Share a character's favorite recipe. Make it and include pictures.
- 11. Write a list of discussion topics for a book club reading your book
- 12. Create a Pinterest board for each of your characters and talk about them on your blog
- 13. What elements from your life were weaved throughout your latest book?
- 14. Share a post about your characters' favorite hobbies
- 15. Interview one of your characters
- 16. Talk about the supporting characters in your new book (who are they and what inspired them)
- 17. Talk about what you hope your readers take away from your new book
